## ***Yonri to ONRI next:***

### **2000 Foundation of Yonri**

- President one of the board members of ONRI
- Set plan: learning environment where youth can learn
- Set activities: not attractive to pragmatic gen./screenagers
- So: no involvement in plan of the people it is about!

### **2004 New board**

- Young ONRI staff member as secretary
- Own plan making, but no own budget
- Every activity needed to be pre-approved (and this took time!)

## ***Yonri to ONRI*next:**

### **2006 Start new thinking**

- No more direct interference from ONRI (of course accountability!)
- Development of vision, mission and strategy
- Set activities: not attractive to pragmatic gen./screenagers
- So: no involvement in plan of the people it is about!

### **2008 Ed Nijpels era**

- New full organisational structure (working title: *ONRI*next)
- Recognition of work done by Yonri
- Appointment of Yonri president into ONRI board (full powers)
- Change of name from Yonri to *ONRI*next
